

Carmen Dixon Rosenzweig is the creator of the blog All About Race. She describes herself as "the moderate militant" who guides truth seekers who have a strong conscience and a desire to make the world a better place by showing them how to engage in authentic and productive interracial conversations about race armed with understanding but without shame or overwhelming fear. Prior to creating All About Race, Carmen spent more than a decade on the front lines of broadcast journalism, corporate public relations and crisis management honing her skills as an expert communicator. As an ABC News producer, Carmen won three Emmy Awards. She is a graduate of Yale University.

Now Carmen is a frequent guest on NPR, a featured columnist for AOL BlackVoices, the host of "All About Race on the Radio" on BlogTalkRadio and conducts seminars and motivational presentations from the place on the racial frontier where the quest for understanding and tolerance faces down anger, reluctance and fear.
