## VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2019 general election, a valid form of **identification (ID) is required**. Identification may include, but is not limited to, any current and valid photo ID: NJ driver's license, military or other government ID, student or job ID, store membership card, or U.S. passport;

Or

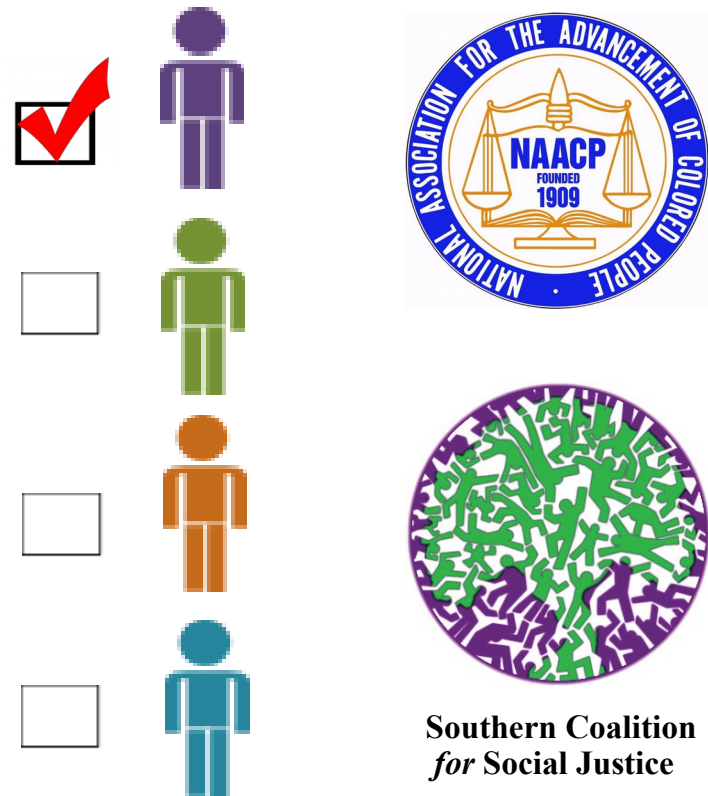
Bank statement, car registration, government check or document, non-photo NJ driver's license, rent receipt, sample ballot, utility bill, or any other official document.

# VOTER REGISTRATION

# EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the 2019 election, you must be **registered by Tuesday, October 15, 2019** (at least 21 days prior to Election Day).

There is no same-day or Election Day registration.

## REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in New Jersey, you must be:

a U.S. citizen;

a resident of a NJ county for 30 days before an election;  
and

at least 18 years old by the next general election.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, you can complete a new voter registration form after the terms of incarceration, probation, and parole are complete. If you are a pretrial detainee or on bail pending appeal, you do not lose your right to vote.

## EARLY VOTING

There is not a statewide early voting program.

## ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered New Jersey voters may request and mail an absentee ballot without an excuse.

Request must be received by the County Clerk **by**

**Tuesday, October 29, 2019** (seven days before an election); OR

Must be **requested in person by 3:00 pm on November 4, 2019.**

Ballot must be **received by close of polls on Election Day.**
